KEY MEDICARE CHANGES

- The grafts are reimbursed at \$127.14/cm²
- Discarded product is no longer separately reimbursed
- Separate application reimbursement remains in place for eligible skin substitute procedures*

As a result, product sizing and utilization are increasingly important and larger wounds require efficient treatment strategies.

*Application payment rates vary by facility due to geographic wage index adjustments.

A RANGE OF PRODUCTS TO MEET YOUR NEEDS

EPIXPRESS®

EPIXPRESS is a lyophilized human placental allograft that includes the amnion layer, intermediate layer, and chorion layer. It is intended for use as a barrier to provide a protective environment in acute and chronic wounds.



EPICORD®

EPICORD is a Dehydrated Human Umbilical Cord (DHUC) allograft that provides a protective environment on wounds and thereby supports the healing process. It is comprised of an Extracellular Matrix (ECM) of Hyaluronic Acid (HA) and collagen.



EPIEFFECT®

EPIEFFECT is a lyophilized human placental allograft membrane that includes the amnion layer, intermediate layer, and chorion layer. It provides a protective barrier on wounds and thereby supports the healing process.



EPIFIX®

EPIFIX is a placental tissue allograft composed of dehydrated human amnion/chorion membrane (DHACM). Available in sheet and mesh/fenestrated configurations.

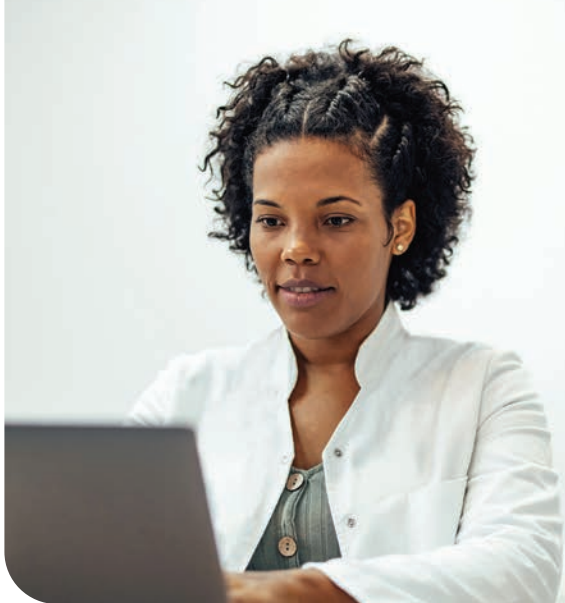
